

Technical instructions

Papers in the English language must be complete, i.e. including a summary, references and graphic enclosures. Editors reserve the right of proofreading. Czech (Slovak) authors may submit a copy in the Czech (Slovak) language. The original papers are to be supplied in electronic form (3.5" floppy, CD or by E-mail) plus a hard copy with the specification of the placement of graphics and/or other comments of the authors.

Graphic attachments (maps, cartographs, diagrams) are to be generated in one of graphic softwares and formatted as .jpg or .eps. Graphs are to be preferably submitted in Excel including a source table. Tables are to be preferably supplied in Excel, too. Colour photographs of high technical quality may be supplied in electronic form at a resolution of ... dpi or on glossy paper at a maximum size of 15 x 10 cm. All attachments must be numbered, identified and containing an information on the source. Each graphic enclosure must be supplied as a separate file.

Quotations in the text are to include an information about the author and year of paper publication, e.g.: *the difficulties were explained by Vitásek (1970)* or ... *with paleotectonic structural elements (Karásek, 1991)*.

Contributions are to be supplied in MS Word with the text unformatted. Individual paragraphs are separated by the *enter* key. Individual words are separated by just one space character. The internal structure of papers is characterized by subtitles. Indentations and footnotes are acceptable on the condition that they are generated electronically.

The title of the paper is to be followed by the name(s) and surname(s) of author(s) without academic title(s), then by a summary in the English language (plus a summary in Czech or Slovak in the case of Czech or Slovak authors), keywords and the proper text of the contribution. Authors' names with academic titles, scientific ranks and address(es) of their workplaces including postal codes and electronic addresses are to be added at the end of each paper.

Shortened references in alphabetical order will be placed behind the Authors's addresses. If the author is unknown, the work will be enlisted by the first letter of the paper title. Examples:

GREER-WOOTTEN, B. (2003): *Radical Alterity and the Concept of Regional Identity*. In: Vaishar, A., Zapletalová, J., Munzar, J. (eds.): *Regional Geography and its Applications*. Regiograph Brno, p. 44-50.

The publication of contributions in Moravian Geographical Reports is free of charge but without honorarium. Authors will receive one free copy of the journal issue and separate copies of their contribution. Unreclaimed materials are not returned.
